**DAIS** (Domestic Abuse Intervention Services) works passionately and effectively to ensure the safety and well-being of domestic violence survivors and their families, and to change societal attitudes that perpetuate violence and the abuse of power.

**MUM** (Madison Urban Ministry) is an interfaith social justice organization working to spur social change in and around Dane County. MUM addresses issues of race and poverty and has multiple programs to assist those affected by incarceration and their families.

**Reconciling Ministries Network** mobilizes United Methodists of all sexual orientations and gender identities to transform our Church and world into the full expression of Christ's inclusive love.


**Bethany Peace Fellowship** meets regularly to learn more about peace issues and find ways to promote peace in our lives, our country, and our world. Rather than being a protest group, the goal is to focus on positive action for the advancement of peace.

**MOSES** (Madison Organizing in Strength, Equality and Solidarity) focuses on prison reform at the county and state level. It also works to help those being released to reintegrate back into society as productive members of the community.

## Global Mission Involvement

Bethany provides support to the following missionaries:

**Paul Webster** is a rural economic and development specialist, and co-directs the **Mujila Falls Agriculture Center** in northwest **Zambia**. At the farm, men and women of the Lunda tribe learn sustainable and appropriate methods to grow crops and manage livestock.



**Imagine No Malaria** is the United Methodist Church's \$75 million commitment to the global fight against malaria, seeking to cultivate partnerships and implement malaria control programs across Africa. The approach includes:

- Education of families and health workers, prevention and treatment programs for affected communities, such as bed nets and improved access to medications;
- Revitalizing health facilities;
- Supporting hospital and health care human resource development.



**Africa University** was established in 1994 in Old Mutara in Zimbabwe, Africa University, and has become one of Africa's leading universities working with world class universities around the globe. It is a Christian university, originally established by the United Methodist Church. Its departments of study include Agricultural Natural Resources, Management and Administration, Humanities and Social Sciences, Health Sciences, Peace, Leadership and Governance, and Theology.
